Materials List and Paint Process Instructions

MATERIALS

The Pottstown Public Art Project has specified the following acrylic-based products for use:

1. PRIMER:

• BULLS EYE 1-2-3 (Zinsser)

2. PAINT:

Must use paint designed for outdoor mural use and colors selected must be lightfast and designed to hold up to sunlight and outdoor elements. Below are examples of approved brands.

- GOLDEN ARTIST COLOR
- NOVA COLOR
- 3. ISOLATION COAT (layer between paint & protective clear coat)
 - 1. GOLDEN ARTIST COLOR: Soft Gel Gloss
 - 2. NOVA GEL

4. PROTECTIVE VARNISH / CLEAR COAT

- GOLDEN ARTIST COLOR: MSA Varnish
- NOVA COLOR VARNISH

PROCESS FOR PAINT APPLICATION:

- 1. Clean the surface with biodegradable cleaner.
- 2. Rinse and allow to completely dry.
- 3. Sand the cabinet with sandpaper until the surface feels rough. Be sure to wipe all surfaces with a damp cloth to remove all dust/grit after sanding. It is recommended that all boxes be sanded prior to painting, as many may have an anti-graffiti coating that will interfere with paint adhesion.
- 4. Apply one coat of metal primer on box.
- 5. After primer coat is completely dry, a colored base coat should be applied.
- 6. When the design is complete, apply isolation coat and protective varnish/clear coat.
